Notice is hereby given of the City's intent to submit an application to the Texas General Land Office (GLO) for a Texas Community Development Block Grant - Mitigation (CDBG-MIT) Program.

Application 1. Wastewater Treatment Plant Retrofit – Local Cost Share

The application is for \$8,827,066.25 the local cost share for Phase I and Phase II of the Wastewater Treatment Plant Retrofit project under the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program (HMGP).

The City is offering citizens the opportunity to make comments on the draft of substantially complete grant application for fourteen (14) days from the date of this posting. The public is encouraged to submit comments regarding the cost sharing application for the HMGP project that will mitigate the devastating effects of natural disasters as well ensure the project is in line with environmental regulations, affirmatively further fair housing activities, and, if applicable, minimizing displacement of persons by future events.
