18 **1. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS**

19 Vice-Chair Antrobus stated that she attended the North Prairie Conference in the beginning  
20 of June and requested that this item be added to the Action Item Checklist.

21 **2. COMMITTEE BUSINESS**

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23 **2.1 Update on recent and ongoing park activities and improvements from Committee**  
24 **members, and park reports from Committee Park Checks. (Committee)**

25 Member Harper requested that Baybrook Park be added to the next Quarterly Report to  
26 Seabrook City Council so that Council can see all the changes made.

27 The windows at the Carothers greenhouse need to be opened for the plants to have some  
28 airflow.

29 **2.2 City Staff update.**

30 Public Works Director, Kevin Padgett, notified the Committee that the City was denied the  
31 trail extension grant but was encouraged to apply again at a later time.

32 **2.3 Discussion and approval of the Action Item Checklist. (Committee)**

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- 34 • Volunteers: The Committee Members gave their volunteer hours to Chair Burton during the meeting to keep records current.
  - 35 • Birding Event: The bird count held on May 4, 2019 was well attended. More signage  
36 is needed during the bird count to help guide any attendees who arrive late. The

- 37 birding seminar held on May 16, 2019 at the Public Works facility over birding  
38 migration was also well attended
- 39 • Mile Maker Trail Map: No updated information at the time.
  - 40 • Seabrook Prairie: No updated information at the time.
  - 41 • Seed Library and Community Garden: The seed library is up and running, they are  
42 now accepting seeds. The library is eager to start a community garden.
  - 43 • Woodlands Regeneration: No updated information at the time.
  - 44 • Irrigation System at Pine Gully: No updated information at the time.
  - 45 • Specific Bird Feeder Removal: The bird feeder located in the parking lot of Robinson  
46 Park has been removed and will be replaced when a Scout is needing a project to do.
  - 47 • Recycling Flyer: No updated information at the time.
  - 48 • Carothers Coastal Gardens Task Force: Deputy City Manager, Sean Landis, stated  
49 that he met with Member Popken – Chair of the Task Force, Seabrook Council  
50 Member Hammann, and Public Works Director, Kevin Padgett to strategize about the  
51 first Task Force meeting in July. Member Popken wrote the Task Force with  
52 information about what to expect at the first meeting. The first Task Force meeting  
53 will be more of a procedure meeting. A tabulation of what the facility was used for  
54 will be discussed along with all initial presentations made by City staff. Member  
55 Popken was given the Master Plan for Carothers to present to the Task Force.  
56 Recently, Seabrook City Council passed a Resolution that truly defines the scope of  
57 work the Task Force should work on.

58 Operationally, the City of Seabrook has stopped manicuring and just started during a  
59 general mow of the property. Worker hours are not being tracked at the moment.

- 60 • Keep Texas Beautiful: The City and Open Space and Trails Committee members are  
61 continuing their education with Keep Texas Beautiful.
- 62 • Texas Park and Wildlife: The grant application was denied.
- 63 • TPWD Bird Conservation Grant: The Committee awaits the results of a grant  
64 application.
- 65 • TxDOT SRTS Sidewalk Grant: Recently, City staff visited the TxDOT office to get  
66 insight as to what is needed to apply for this grant. City staff is awaiting letters of  
67 support from the surrounding schools and library for the grant submission.
- 68 • Trail lighting: This project is currently ongoing.
- 69 • Expansion of Parking at Robinson Park: The parking lot is expanded per the design  
70 of our City Engineer. 11 parking spots are available and a coral fence and curb stops  
71 have been added. A LED light will be installed soon.

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
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
