**AMENDMENT NO. 2
AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR
BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2020 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2021
FOR CITY DEPARTMENT ENCUMBRANCES**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE AMOUNT OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2020 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2021 BY AUTHORIZING CERTAIN ADDITIONS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,752,692 FOR GENERAL AND CAPITAL RESERVE CIP FUND 28 FUND; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO FACILITATE THE CHANGES IDENTIFIED; AND FINDING AVAILABLE UNENCUMBERED FUNDS FOR THE SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION AND/OR RESERVE REDUCTION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seabrook Approved Budget Ordinance 2020-24 on September 15, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City received awarded funds in the amount of \$1,752,961.70 from the American Rescue Act on August 23, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager presented, and City Council approved the City's 5 year CIP Plan outlying plans for the American Rescue Act Funds on July 6, 2021, and;

WHEREAS, American Rescue Act Funds are to be transferred to the General Reserve CIP Fund 28; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds it in the public interest to amend the total Fiscal Year 2020/21 Operating Budget for the General Fund and General Reserve CIP Fund 28, by adjusting various budget accounts as outlined in **Exhibit "A"**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Seabrook finds and determines that this budget amendment complies with all requirements under its Charter and laws;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, STATE OF TEXAS:

THAT, the 2020/21 Adopted Budget for the City of Seabrook for the period beginning on October 1, 2020 and ending on September 30, 2021 is hereby amended by decreasing and increasing various funds and department line items in the total amount of \$1,752,692 as set out in **Exhibit "A"**, **American** Rescue Act Funds and as Amendment #2 to FY 2021 attached hereto and incorporated herein.

PASSED, AND APPROVED with a quorum present, by an affirmative vote of a majority of Councilmembers present, in accordance with Seabrook City Charter Section 2.10, on first and final reading this **21st day of September, 2021.**
