GENERAL ELECTION HELD MAY 7, 2022**

**A RESOLUTION AND ORDER CANVASSING THE RETURNS  
AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE CITY OFFICERS  
REGULAR ELECTION HELD ON MAY 7, 2022**

In regular order came to be considered the returns of the City of Seabrook General Election held on the 7th day of May, 2022 for the purpose of electing the hereinafter named officials and it appearing from said returns, duly and legally made, that there were cast at said election valid and legal votes as shown on Exhibit "A" to this Resolution.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF SEABROOK, TEXAS**

- THAT the May 7, 2022 General Election was duly called and was held in accordance with the Texas Election Code and the Seabrook City Charter.
- THAT the City Council has examined such returns and opened and canvassed the votes of such election.
- THAT Edward Klein received 44.22% of the votes for Position 1 (after Recount conducted May 16, 2022 by request of candidate Jackie Rasco); and
- THAT Josh Perrella received 7.25% of the votes for Position 1 (after Recount conducted May 16, 2022 by request of candidate Jackie Rasco): and
- THAT Jackie Rasco received 48.52% of the votes for Position 1 (after Recount conducted May 16, 2022 by request of candidate Jackie Rasco); and
- THAT A runoff election will be held between Edward Klein and Jackie Rasco to determine the duly elected Councilmember for Position 1; and
- THAT Tom Tollett was duly elected as Councilmember, Position 3; and
- THAT Buddy Hammann was duly elected as Councilmember, Position 5; and

THAT said above named parties are hereby declared duly elected to said respective offices, subject to the taking of the oaths of office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas and the Charter of the City of Seabrook, Texas; and

THAT it is further found and determined that, in accordance with the order of this governing body, the City Secretary posted written notice of the date, place and subject of this meeting on the bulletin board located at the City Hall, a place convenient to the public, and said notice had been posted and remained posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the date of this meeting.
