1	On-the-Ground Recycling Outreach with The City of Denton! Texas Recycle Day	11/16/2023	Monica	Denton is a much larger city than Seabrook, with 140,000 residents, 37,000 homes, and two large universities. They used dedicated full-time staff, college interns, and part-time employees to work on the pilots. The pilot programs included: 1. Updating containers- updating the containers to permanently close the lids. 2. Denton ISD- 90% of contamination came from the ISD, so they worked with ISD staff to audit. 3. Cart Tagging Pilot- they used the college interns to look in recycling bins . 4. Do Not Collect List Pilot- staff worked with residents whose audit deemed a no collection status to resolve bin issues within 5-6 days
