



## QUALIFICATIONS FOR JURY SERVICE

(Texas Government Code, Section 62.106, except where noted)

To be qualified as a juror, you must:

- be at least 18 years of age.
- be a citizen of this state and a resident of the city in which you are to serve as a juror.
- be qualified under the Constitution and laws to vote in the county in which you are to serve as a juror (Note: You do not have to be registered to vote to be qualified to vote).
- be of sound mind and good moral character.
- be able to read and write.
- not have been convicted of, or be under indictment or other legal accusation for,
- misdemeanor theft or a felony and be a resident of the municipality for which the court is established (Government Code, Section 62.501).
