NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION

TO THE REGISTERED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, TEXAS:

A general election will be held on May 2, 2026 for the purpose of electing a City Council Member to Position 1, a City Council Member to Position 3, and a City Council Member to Position 5.

The entire corporate limits of the City shall constitute one election precinct and the main Election Day polling place for said election shall be Seabrook City Hall located at 1700 First Street, Seabrook, Texas.

The polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on Election Day.

Early voting shall be conducted by personal appearance and by mail. The period for early voting by personal appearance for the general election shall be April 20 through April 28, 2026. Hart InterCivic's Verity Duo System with KNOWiNK electronic poll pads shall be utilized for all early voting as well as for all voting conducted on Election Day. The Early Voting Clerk for said elections shall be the City Secretary, Rachel Lewis. She shall determine the number of election workers to be hired and arrange for training of all election workers. Early voting by personal appearance for the election shall be conducted at Seabrook City Hall, 1700 First Street, Seabrook, Texas 77586.

Applications may be received by the Early Voting Clerk in the City of Seabrook, and upon receipt will be forwarded immediately to the Harris County Clerk’s Office-Election Department. Applications for a ballot by mail must be received by the Harris County Clerk’s Election Department no later than April 20, 2026, at 5:00 p.m., and may be mailed directly to Teneshia Hudspeth, Harris County Clerk’s Office – Election Department, P.O. Box 1148, Houston, Texas 77251-1148.
