1GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT ALLIANCE COOPERATIVE
PURCHASING PROGRAM**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, TEXAS AUTHORIZING THE CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE 1GOVERNMENT PROCUREMENT ALLIANCE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING PROGRAM FOR GOODS AND SERVICES, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED AGREEMENT FOR SUCH PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the City of Seabrook, Texas has elected to be a customer in a national purchasing cooperative, a program created in accordance with and pursuant to Section 271.102, of the Texas Local Government Code and Chapter 791, Texas Government Code (Interlocal Cooperation Act);

WHEREAS, the City of Seabrook believes that participation in the cooperative purchasing program will be highly beneficial to its taxpayers through the efficiencies and potential savings to be realized; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seabrook desires to participate and join with other entities in an Intergovernmental Cooperative Purchasing Program to purchase products, materials and services for the purpose of fulfilling and implementing their respective public and governmental purposes, needs, objectives, programs, functions, and services; and

WHEREAS, the mission of 1Government Procurement Alliance is to make sure our members receive the benefits of pooled purchasing power, paired with the professionalism and devotion to customer service that includes best pricing available, access to current industry solutions, and more; and

WHEREAS, the Cooperative Member satisfies the requirement to seek competitive bids for the purchase of goods and/or services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, STATE OF TEXAS:

Section 1. That the facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Resolution are hereby found to be true and correct.

Section 2. That the City of Seabrook requests that the 1Governmental Procurement Alliance include the City’s stated needs for all categories to buy products, materials, and services at the best possible pricing without the need for a lengthy procurement process.

Section 3. That the Cooperative is authorized to sign and deliver all necessary requests and other documents in connection therewith for and on behalf of the City of Seabrook when requested, as provided herein.

Section 4. That the Mayor of the City of Seabrook is hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Contract with 1Government Procurement Alliance and all other documents necessary to allow for the purchasing of products from said purchasing alliance, substantially in the form attached hereto as “Exhibit A” and incorporated herein.

Section 5. That execution of this Resolution shall evidence the determination by the City of Seabrook to become a member of the 1Government Procurement Alliance upon the terms and conditions stated in the attached Exhibit A. The City Council has, and at the time of adoption of this Resolution, had, full power and lawful authority to adopt the foregoing Resolution and to confer the obligations, powers, and authority to the person named, who is hereby granted the power to exercise same.

Section 6. The City Manager is hereby designated as a person to act under the direction of, and on behalf the City of Seabrook, in all matters related to the Program as provided for in Texas Local Government Code Section 271.102.
