Recognizing emergency responders for efforts which resulted in the saving of a human life in our community.

Executive Summary / Background:

At 02:20am responders were notified of a medical emergency at this location. Seabrook dispatchers identified the severity of the emergency and requested mutual aid ambulance while coordinating with responders on scene. Seabrook EMS was currently assigned to another emergency and transporting to a local hospital. Seabrook PD and Seabrook VFD responded to the scene for assistance. PD officers found an unconscious subject and began assessing the situation. Officers quickly identified the need for and began CPR. Seabrook volunteer firefighters quickly joined in assisting while waiting for arrival of mutual aid ambulance from Nassau Bay.

This also involved the closing time of the establishment with heavy traffic moving throughout the parking lot. Additionally, Seabrook officers began clearing access for emergency vehicles.

The efficient team coordination of responders and actions taken by PD and VFD resulted in the saving of the subjects life.
