



47           **SECTION 1. FINDINGS OF FACT.**

48  
49           That the facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby  
50 found to be true and correct.

51  
52           **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT TO THE CODE, APPENDIX A, ARTICLE 3,**  
53 **SECTION 3.15.**

54  
55           The Seabrook City Code, Appendix A, Comprehensive Zoning, Article III,  
56 Establishment of Zoning Districts and Associated Uses”, Section 3.15, Comprehensive  
57 Land Use Matrix is hereby amended to allow “Auto Repair/Detailing”, “Auto Rental and  
58 Leasing”, “Quick Lube/Oil Change”, and “Tire Dealers and Service”” as a Conditional  
59 Use in the (146-S) SH 146 South Commercial District and (146-M) SH 146 Main  
60 Commercial Zoning District as shown on Attachment A which is made a part of this  
61 ordinance.

63           **SECTION 3. INCORPORATION INTO THE CODE, PENALTY**  
64 **CLAUSE.**

65  
66           This Ordinance is hereby incorporated and made a part of the Seabrook City  
67 Code. Violation of this ordinance is subject to the penalty section of said Code and  
68 Ordinance, Section 1-15 “General Penalty and 11.06, “Criminal Enforcement” which  
69 provides that any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be  
70 deemed guilty of an offense and, upon conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to  
71 exceed \$2,000.00. Each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

73           **SECTION 4. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES.**

75           All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict or inconsistent with this  
76 Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.

77  
78           **SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.**

80           In the event any clause phrase, provision, sentence, or part of this Ordinance or  
81 the application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be  
82 adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not  
83 affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof  
84 other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the  
85 City of Seabrook, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the  
86 same notwithstanding the omission of any such part thus declared to be invalid or  
87 unconstitutional, whether there be one or more parts.
