TXDOT SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL GRANT FUND APPLICATION

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING CITY OF SEABROOK'S APPLICATION
TO THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION'S 2019 SAFE
ROUTES TO SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE (SRTS) CALL FOR PROJECTS
FOR A CONCRETE SIDEWALK ON N. MEYER AND E. MEYER**

WHEREAS, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) issued a call for projects in February 2019 for communities to apply for funding assistance through the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TASA) and/or Safe Routes to School-Infrastructure (SRTS) Programs; and

WHEREAS, the SRTS funds may be used for development of plans, specifications, and estimates; environmental documentation; and construction of pedestrian and/or bicycle infrastructure. The SRTS funds do not require a local match. As the Project Sponsor, the Local Government would be responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100% of overruns, if any, for SRTS funds; and

WHEREAS, the City of Seabrook has identified a sidewalk project allowing for 800 homes to have access to the elementary and intermediate schools, County Library and multiple City Parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SEABROOK, STATE OF TEXAS:

THAT, the City Council of Seabrook authorizes the City of Seabrook to seek and support funding the project "Meyer Roads' Sidewalk", as described in the Local Government's 2019 TASA/SRTS Detailed Application (including the construction budget, TxDOT's administrative cost, and the required local match, if any) and is willing to commit to the project's development, implementation, construction, maintenance, management, and financing. The City of Seabrook is willing and able to authorize, by resolution or ordinance, the Local Government to enter into an agreement with TxDOT should the project be selected for funding.
