The 10th Annual Seabrook Saltwater Derby Returns September 27th, 2019

Annual Events Draws Bigger Crowds and More prizes

SEABROOK, TX – Galveston Bay will be alive with anglers trying their luck and skill at catching the “big one” in this one-day, multi-species tournament. The Seabrook Saltwater Derby is back for its 10th year, and is scheduled to launch Friday, September 27th, 2019. Once again this popular event will take place at Cabo Bar & Grill located at 2513 NASA Road 1 in Seabrook, .

The Derby kicks off with a Captain’s Meeting starting at 7:00pm on Thursday, September 26th, 2019 at Cabo Bar & Grill. A Calcutta will follow the meeting and is open to the public.

The tournament starts at 5:30 a.m. on Friday, September 27th, and continues until the official weigh-in time at 3:00p.m.

According to the official rules, anglers can legally fish from public waters either by boat, wade fishing, piers or banks. Boundaries are from Rollover Pass to San Luis Pass including the beachfront. All waters fished must be accessible to the public and connected to the Galveston Bay estuary system.

Fish categories include speckled trout and redfish divisions with a generous Flounder pot and a Texas Team Slam Pot for an extra fee. Award categories include Heaviest Individual Red Fish, Heaviest Individual Speckled Trout, Heaviest Team Stringer of Redfish (3 Reds), Heaviest Team Stringer of Trout (4 Trout). Each entrant can weigh in their best 4 speckled trout and 3 redfish separately. Weigh-in takes place at 3 p.m., and all anglers must be in line with fish in hand to qualify.

Thousands of dollars in cash and prizes will be awarded in each category and the \$90.00 registration fee covers the entire Derby duration. All entrants will receive a t-shirt, lunch, and draft beer.

The early entry fee is \$90.00 per person and ends on Tuesday, September 11, 2019. The late entry fee is \$100.00 per person: All entry fees and registration forms must be submitted **NO LATER THAN** Wednesday, Sept. 25, at noon. There will be no entrants accepted after this **DEADLINE**.






